

# Tax-Credit Envelope Stuffer

This envelope stuffer can be copied and mailed with paychecks, public assistance checks, bills, and other mailings. Local phone and utility companies, for example, might send copies with their early 2008 bills to customers. Employers are encouraged to include a "payroll stuffer" with employee paychecks or distribute with W-2's.

### **You could be Eligible for EITC!**

Did you work in 2007? You may be eligible for the Earned Income Credit. If so, you'll owe less in taxes and you could get cash back. Even if you don't owe income tax, you can get the EIC! To qualify you must meet the following rules:

- ✓ You must have a valid Social Security Number
- ✓ You must have earned income from employment or from self-employment.
- ✓ Your filing status cannot be married, filing separately.
- ✓ You must be a U.S. citizen or resident alien all year, or a nonresident alien married to a U.S. citizen or resident alien and filing a joint return.
- ✓ You **cannot** be a qualifying child of another person.
- ✓ If you do not have a qualifying child, you must: be age 25 but under 65 at the end of the year, live in the United States for more than half the year, and not qualify as a dependent of another person.

### **Tax time can pay even more. Claim your CTC refund!**

Many families that earned more than \$11,300 may qualify for the Child Tax Credit (CTC) refund – up to \$1,000 for each qualifying child under 17. See your tax instructions and get Form 8812.

### **Free tax preparation & e-filing is available!**

If you worked in 2007, had children living with you and earned less than \$ 39,783, you may be eligible for free tax help. If you did not have children living with you and earned less than \$ 14,590, you may be eligible. For more information call 211 or 706-327-3999.
