VITA (VOLUNTEER INCOME TAX ASSISTANCE PROGRAM)

This program provides free tax assistance to individuals earning \$49,000 or less and ensures that individuals receive all eligible tax credits. Last year the program served 2,238 people in the Chattahoochee Valley, and returned nearly \$3.3 million back to residents.

familywise[®] PRESCRIPTION DRUG DISCOUNT CARD

This program provides a discount on prescription medication- the average savings is 30%. The card is free and there is no enrollment.

bornlearning[™]

This program focuses on early learning and its purpose is to help parents and caregivers turn everyday moments into learning moments. The Chattahoochee Valley has a total of seven Born Learning trails.
